• The Memorial Trophy (Previously the Arthur Mullens)— MGLS members only

Awarded for the highest scoring entry in section 10

• Don Wilkinson Trophy

Awarded to the entry that scores the highest number of judging points for an individual open freeform, sections 4, 14 & 15.

• Laurie & Val Saint Trophy

Awarded to the entry that scores the highest number of judging points for an individual novice silver piece.

• Lionel Whitby Memorial Trophy

Awarded to the entry that scores the highest number of judging points for an individual open novelty gemcraft entry, section 29.

• Fossicker's Cup

Awarded for the best entry found on a field trip see section 33 (Judges Choice)

• Best in Show

Awarded to the single entry that scores the highest number of judging points in an individual section (excluding showcases)

• Show Champion

Show Champion is determined by the highest accumulated points scored by an individual.

Entries must be entered as found however entries can be partially slabbed but must not be worked.

Notes for completing Competition Entry Form and submitting entries:

- Complete details of your name, lapidary club and phone number at the top of the form.
- Write the class number you are entering in the "Class No." column.
- If you are entering multiple entries in any class (maximum of three entries per class) then please repeat that class for each entry. No descriptions of pieces are required, only class numbers.
- Each entry must be wrapped in soft paper (eg. paper towel, toilet paper), and placed in a small zip-lock bag.
- Faceting entries must be presented in a gem box and have the name of the material on the box.
- As per Australia Post requirements, the packaging for sharp-edged or pointed items in the metalcraft classes must comprise:
 - o primary wrapping with the sharp edges or points wrapped in or protected by cork, polyurethane foam or similar material
 - o an outer rigid container of metal, wood, strong plastic or other rigid material.
- If you require your entries returned by post: An addressed, Prepaid / Express Post Satchel (or similar prepaid postage) must be provided when you submit your entries. Please ensure that the satchel, bag or box is of a suitable size and type to contain all entries to be returned and any additional protective material required is provided. Please ensure that your address details have been fully completed and all postage paid.
